



# **CURRENT PORTFOLIO POSITIONING**

The North Square Tactical Growth Fund started April with an allocation of 83.9% domestic equity, 7.64% international equity, 4.67% fixed income, and 3.79% money market. Market weakness across asset classes resonated in our quantitative ETF rankings and we de-risked throughout the month. We exited ETF positions holding biotechnology, semiconductors, municipal bonds, international large capitalization growth,

and domestic growth mid cap and small capitalization ETFs. We didn't add any holdings during the month due to no ETFs meeting our criteria of compensation for risk. We are entering May with the Fund invested 67.9% in domestic equity and 32.1% in money market securities. We will continue to monitor our model for weakness in our holdings as well as what we consider strength in unowned ETFs.

The Sharpe Ratio was developed by Nobel laureate William F. Sharpe and is used to help investors understand the return of an investment compared to its risk. The ratio is the average return earned in excess of the risk-free rate per unit of volatility or total risk.
